STAFF DATABASE REPORTING via the DATA QUALITY 2 (DQ2) SYSTEM

- **The major update for the Staff Database for 2019-20 and forward is that database reporting will be exclusively via the new DQ2 Staff reporting system.**
- Correspondence regarding this update was provided to District MIS Directors and Staff Database Contacts on May 20, 2019.
- Required reporting via DQ2 commences with Survey 8, 2019-20
- The DQ2 Staff Pilot was made available for districts use to submit 1819 Staff files which has the look and feel of the actual production site for 1920.

- Staff files submitted via the NWRDC mainframe system will not be processed.

DATABASE REPORTING ISSUES

- **Disaster Affected Student reporting**

(Prior School Status/Student Attendance format; Data element #131545)

- Reporting for this data element should not roll-over from year to year
- Status of reporting is what has happened in the current school year
- Example of data issues: some districts were still reporting students relocating as a result of the 2010 Gulf Oil Spill.

- **GEFE (F62801) report -vs- GQUH (F71251) report**

(Student Demographic Information format; Lunch Status data element #146025)

GEFE: Lunch Status Data by Programs / GQUH: Title I Public School Eligibility Survey Data

- Both reports display Lunch Status data by programs
(Programs: Eligibility by Survey Application / Provision 2 / CEP)
- GEFE report displays Lunch Status data for all students
- GQUH report displays Lunch Status data for students ages 5-17



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Lunch Status Database Reporting Issues

Lunch Status issues happen often in database reporting. The main discrepancy is the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) code designated for a school.

For Survey Periods 2 & 3 the Florida Department of Agricultural and Consumer Services (DOACS) provides a list of NSLP codes for Florida's public schools to the department. This list creates the F71447 Reference File used in the Database process.

The DOACS file may show a school as an "Application" school, whereas the district's Food Service office may have the school listed as a "CEP" or "Provision 2" school. Once the student records for that school are submitted to the Database for processing the records are flagged with errors because their data is contrary to the DOACS reference file.

At that point districts must work with their Food Service Office and DOACS to verify the NSLP program of the school and correct the records accordingly.

The following slides show the valid Lunch Status codes that apply to each NSLP program – Survey Application, CEP & Provision 2.

Lunch Status Reporting (#146025)

Year: **2019-20**

Data Element Name: **Lunch Status**

Lunch Status is defined as the student's eligibility status for participation in the National School Lunch Program. Eligibly status is based upon the type of National School Lunch Program Provision offered in the student's School Number, Current Enrollment.

Code Definition/Example

Community Eligibility Provision

- C The student is enrolled in a USDA – approved Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) school and is identified as eligible for free meals based upon the Direct Certification... (Only FL Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS) - approved CEP schools use this code.)
- N The student is enrolled in a USDA – approved Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) school and is NOT identified as eligible for free or reduced priced meals based upon the Direct Certification (Only FDACS - approved CEP schools use this code.)
- R The student is enrolled in a USDA – approved Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) school and is identified as eligible for reduced price meals based upon the Direct Certification... (Only FL Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS) - approved CEP schools use this code.)

Eligibility Status Determined by Survey Application

- 0 The student did not apply for free or reduced price meals.
- 1 The student applied for free or reduced price meals but is not eligible.
- 3 The student is eligible for reduced-price meals. (Based on FRL eligibility survey only.)
- D The student is identified as eligible for free meals based upon the Direct Certification determination...
- E The student is identified as eligible for reduced price meals based upon the Direct Certification determination...
- F The student is eligible for free meals. (Based on FRL eligibility survey only.)

Provision 2

- 4 The student is enrolled in a USDA-approved Provision 2 school.

Z or Not Applicable

- Z Unknown. This code should be used only for private school students participating in Title I programs and (optionally) for reporting survey 6 information.

DOACS Reference File (F71447)

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHIC – STATE VALIDATION RULES

5E. For Survey Periods 2 and 3, if the District Number, Current Enrollment and the District Number, Current Instruction/Service are equal and the School Number, Current Enrollment is found on the **National School Lunch Program (NSLP) Reference file - F71447 (provided by the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services)**, these are the conditions for reporting.....

- If the NSLP designated at the school is determined by collection of **Free or Reduced Priced Lunch Eligibility Applications**, then Lunch Status must equal 0, 1, 3, D, E or F.
- If the NSLP is designated as a school providing **Provision 2**, then Lunch Status must equal 4.
- If the NSLP is designated as a school providing **Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)**, then Lunch Status must equal C, R or N.

-state validation-

The match should be made using Year; District Number, Current Enrollment; and School Number, Current Enrollment.

DATABASE REPORTING ISSUES

- **Student Attendance reporting:**

(Prior School Status/Student Attendance format; Days Present Annual (#113225) and Days Absent, Annual (#112025))

- Report available for districts' download & review –

F70488 Student Average Attendance / Membership

- Particular attention should be given those schools where % Present is 100% or less than 85%, as well where the Days Absent column shows '0.'

- **Teacher Attendance reporting:**

(Staff Demographic Information format; Days Present (#203140), Days Absent, Personal (#203080) / Sick (#203090) / Temporary Duty Elsewhere (#203100) / Other (#203070))

- Issue: districts 'default' data ('0' / '180') in these fields & forget to update
- There is no 'one' answer; districts must be diligent in reporting accurate data.
