Innovative Course Reporting

- Let's define some terms
 - Brick and mortar: in-person, at school of instruction
 - Virtual: delivered on-line through District Virtual School Franchise or FLVS (70xx schools)
 - **Innovative**: instruction used to provide parents choice during the pandemic per the district reopening plan



Innovative Course Reporting

- Innovative course participation is subject to class size
- No core courses designated exempt from class size should have students marked as Innovative (i.e. blended, virtual, home school, etc.)
- All other existing class size rules still apply
- No existing reporting outside of Innovative has not changed
- Just having Innovative students as part of the class does not qualify the brick and mortar class as blended learning



Location of Student Data Element

- Chosen as the way to collect data on the use of Innovative course delivery as outlined in the District's Reopening Plan
- Assigned at the student course level
- The new code in the database manual is "I"

Code	Definition/Example
1	The student is not located in a public school district facility during the regular school day for the innovative instruction course.



Facility Type Designation

- On the Teacher Course format
- For Innovative courses, Facility type is School District Facility code "00" regardless of teacher location
- May utilize FISH numbers for non-standard classrooms

- Will be collected on the SESIR format using the Incident,
 Type data element

- Incident Type is "HSN"
- Incident Date will be zero filled
- Incident Involvement Type is "Z"
- Incident Related fields are "Z"
