

### Relationship Between MIS and Accountability

Survey data is reported timely and accurately.

Survey data is compiled and initial student eligibility is determined. Eligible students are provided back to districts for review via applications or review process.

Final calculations are released using the updated data.



# **Applications**

- Ensures that data included in accountability calculations are up-to-date and accurate.
- Primary District Accountability Coordinators are responsible for these applications and for granting access to district/school personnel who need access.
- Fall/Winter Applications
- Spring Applications



## Fall/Winter Applications

- Graduation Rate Cohort Corrections
- College and Career Acceleration
  - This is now a review process instead of an application.
- Accountability Match Process
  - Not a web application, but data used to populate spring applications.
  - Files are provided during survey 2 and survey 3 reporting.
  - This is the process that will tell districts which kids will be included in accountability.
- Roster Verification Tool (RVT)
  - The application is open twice a year, once with survey 2 rosters and once with survey 3 rosters.



## **Spring Applications**

- School Types
- Student Data Updates
- Prior Year Assessment Matching
- Assessment Matching
  - Spring Assessments are loaded during the appeals process after the initial release of schools grades.
  - To include any additional spring assessment matches through the Assessment Matching application, an appeal must be submitted.
- RVT
  - Survey 3 rosters are available for review.

### Federal Uniform Graduation Rate

- All students must be accounted for.
- Only standard diplomas are included in the numerator.
- Does not remove transfers to adult education programs (remain in denominator).
- Assigns DJJ students back to their most recent Florida public high school.

# DJJ Accountability Ratings

- DJJ Accountability Ratings use data over a 3year period.
- For students enrolled in a DJJ program, both Non-DJJ enrollment data and DJJ enrollment data are incorporated into the calculations.
  - Example Attendance
- While not every district has a DJJ program, every district DOES send and receive students to and from DJJ programs; therefore, the following information is relevant to ALL districts.
