What is FTE? What is FEFP?

In alignment with the Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP), the unit of measure is known as an FTE (Full Time Equivalent), which is considered **one student in membership and in attendance for 180 school days**. The Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP) is **the primary mechanism for funding the operating costs of Florida school districts**; this includes both charter schools and traditional public schools. **membership and in attendance for 180 school days**.




How is FTE Calculated?




Examples : Regular ed students , no special services.





1 Fulltime 5th Grade (1200 Mins) <mark>FEFP of 102</mark> = 1 FTE x 1.00 = <mark>1.00</mark>







Base Student Allocation (BSA)

The dollar amount set annually by the Legislature to provide FEFP base funding for the fiscal year 2022-23 is:











Examples :

1 Fulltime KG (1200 Mins) FEFP of 101 = 1 FTE x 1.126= 1.126 X \$4,587.40 = <mark>\$5,165.41</mark>



1 Fulltime 5th Grade (1200 Mins) FEFP of 103 = 1 FTE x 1.00 = 1.00 X \$4,587.40 = <mark>\$4,587.40</mark>






District Cost Differential

An adjustment that recognizes differences in the cost of living among the school districts


Weighted FTE x BSA x DCD = Base Funding

Examples :

1 Fulltime KG (1200 Mins) FEFP of 101 = 1 FTE x 1.126 = 1.126 X \$4,587.40 = \$5,165.41 X 0.9937 = \$5,132.87


1 Fulltime 5th Grade (1200 Mins) FEFP of 102 = 1 FTE x 1.00 = 1.00 X \$4,587.40 = \$4,587.40 X 0.9937 = $\frac{4,558.49}{4,558.49}$

Examples : Students receiving special services (ESE)


1 Fulltime KG (1200 Mins) FEFP of 255 = 1 FTE x 3.674= 5.401 X \$4,587.40 = \$24,776.55 X 0.9937 = <mark>\$24,620.46</mark>



1 Fulltime 5th Grade (1200 Mins) FEFP of 254 = 1 FTE x 3.674 = 3.674 X \$4,587.40 = \$16,854.11 X 0.9937 = \$16,747.93







Additional or Add-on FTE

Survey 4:

Students who pass EOC without course enrollment (1/6 FTE)

Survey 5:

Early Graduation


Student receives an associate degree through a dual enrollment program with a grade point average of 3.0 or better *NEW*

Dual enrollment general education course with a grade of "A" *NEW*

Virtual FTE

Survey 4 FTE

Funded on successful completion



Here comes the auditor...

Only virtual courses reported in Survey 2 or 3 can be reported for FTE funding <u>beyond the 180-</u> <u>day school year</u> and before the deadline for amending Survey 4.





Maximum 1 FTE per student

If a student already has a full schedule in the brick & mortar school, the district will not earn additional funding for virtual classes students take on-top of that.

How can we mess up FTE?

Data Entry Error

- Very common
- Hard to spot except by schools

MIS Error

- Not very common
- Usually due to new MIS
- Make sure you understand the procedures for extracting data

System Error

- Not very common
- Verify changes and systems calculations
- Perform self-audits

No Funding for ELL

District reported no students in FEFP category 130

District received no error messages

Must mean our information system isn't working, right?
