MSIX is a web-based application that links State migrant systems to produce a single Consolidated Student Record containing the Migrant Education Program (MEP) minimum data elements (MDEs) to not only analyze national migrant trends, but also facilitate:





Child Count Logic

MSIX Child Count Logic | Category 1

Children appear on the Category 1 Children Included list if one of the dates that establishes residency (Enrollment Date, Withdrawal Date, Residency Date, Residency Verification Date) occurs during the performance period satisfies all of the following criteria:

- a) This date must occur **on or after** the child's 3rd birthday **and before** the child's 22nd birthday.
- b) The Qualifying Arrival Date (QAD) must occur on or before this date.
- c) The Eligibility Expiration Date must occur on or after this date.
- d) If a Graduation/HSE Date is submitted, it must occur on or after this date.
- e) Enrollment Type associated with this date must be 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, or 06.

MSIX Child Count Logic | Category 2

Children appear on the Category 2 Children Included list if they are included in the Category 1 Included list AND the date that establishes residency (Enrollment Date, Withdrawal Date, Residency Date, Residency Verification Date) occurs during the performance period and satisfies all of the following criteria:

- a) This date must occur **on or after** the child's 3rd birthday **and before** the child's 22nd birthday.
- b) The Qualifying Arrival Date (QAD) must occur on or before this date.
- c) The Eligibility Expiration Date must occur on or after this date.
- d) If a Graduation/HSE Date is submitted, it must occur on or after this date.
- e) Enrollment Type associated with this date must be 03 Summer/Intersession MEP-Funded Project.



Data Quality Issues

- 1. Overwriting historical enrollment records
- 2. Missing Residency Verification Date after child turns 3
- 3. Qualifying Arrival Date / Eligibility Expiration Date pair > 36 months minus 1 day
- 4. Correct Enrollment Type not Submitted
- 5. Children being counted in current performance period (2022-2023) Category 2 Child Count with Enrollment Date in previous performance period (2021 2022)
 - 1. As of June 6, 2023, this is true for 326 Florida children







A new MSIX Enhancement allows State Data Administrators to view Data in Student Information Reports by Region, District, and School.








Once the radio button Florida District is selected, users can search for Districts they would like to view or select ALL.






