

Relationship Between MIS and Accountability

Survey data are reported timely and accurately.

Survey data are compiled and initial student eligibility is determined.

Eligible students are provided back to districts for review via applications or review process. Final calculations are released using the updated data.



Applications/Review Processes

- Ensure that data included in accountability calculations are up-to-date and accurate.
- Primary District Accountability Coordinators are responsible for these applications and for granting access to district/school personnel who need access.
- Fall/Winter Applications and Review Processes.
- Spring Applications and Review Processes.



Fall/Winter Applications and Review Processes

- Graduation Rate Cohort Corrections
 - This is a web application used in making corrections/updates to the 4-year graduation rate cohort.
- College and Career Acceleration
 - This is now a review process instead of an application.
- Accountability Match Process
 - This is a review process involved in determining which data are used to populate spring applications.
 - Files are provided during Survey 2 and Survey 3 reporting.
 - This is the process that will tell districts which student records will be included for accountability purposes.
- Roster Verification Tool (RVT)
 - The application is open twice a year, once in the Fall to review Survey 2 rosters and once in the Spring to review Survey 3 rosters.
 - This application is optional to use.



Spring Applications and Review Processes

- Student Data Updates
 - This application allows districts to make updates to student records that occurred after Survey 3 and prior to Spring testing.
- School Types
 - This is now a review process instead of an application.
- Prior Year Assessment Matching
 - This is now a review process instead of an application.
- Assessment Matching
 - This is now a review process instead of an application.
- RVT
 - Survey 3 rosters are available for review.



Key Dates and Timelines for Accountability Processes

 - Occurs during the Survey 2 and 3 amendment periods.

Month	Activity
Summer	 School Grades, School Improvement Ratings and District Grades are released. INDV files are provided to districts. The School Accountability appeals process opens. VAM calculations for FAST ELA, FAST Mathematics and Algebra 1 are processed.
Late Summer/Fall Semester	 The School Accountability appeals process closes 30 days after the release of the INDV files. The Bureau provides VAM results for teachers to school districts via the ShareFile website and the VAM Data Visualization Tool.
	The School Accountability appeals decisions are issued.



Month	Activity
Fall Semester	 Updates to Primary Accountability Contacts are due from the Superintendent. Updates to additional accountability contacts are due from the Primary Accountability Contact. School and Teacher Accountability ShareFile access are updated for all districts.
	 Beginning of the accountability match process for Survey 2. Staff evaluations are due via Survey 5 submission. Final Survey 5 data are pulled for staff evaluations. Final Survey 5 data are pulled for the preliminary unadjusted graduation rate cohort.
	 Final date for districts to submit requested changes for alternative school status for accountability purposes. The Graduation Rate Cohort Corrections web application opens. The Fall Survey 2 RVT opens.
	 The Graduation Rate Cohort Corrections web application closes. The accountability match process closes for Survey 2. Final Survey 2 data are pulled for accountability purposes.



Month	Activity
Spring Semester	 2023-2024 Graduation Rates are released (mid December/early January). A memorandum is sent regarding the identification of ESE Center schools for School Accountability.
	 Final date for districts to confirm ESE Center schools for School Accountability. Beginning of the accountability match process for Survey 3.
	The Spring Survey 3 RVT opens.



Month	Activity
Spring Semester (continued)	 The accountability match process closes for Survey 3. Final Survey 3 data are pulled for accountability purposes. The School Types review process begins, which includes school grade selection forms for alternative and ESE Center schools. The Student Data Updates web applications opens. The Prior Year Assessment Matching review process begins. The Assessment Matching review process begins. The preliminary 3-year graduation cohort files are posted to ShareFile. VAM Survey 2/3 Match Request files from the prior year are posted to ShareFile for districts to review and update, as needed. Changes to the VAM Survey 2/3 Match Request files are due.



Month	Activity
Spring Semester (continued)	 The School Types review process ends. The Student Data Updates web application closes. The Prior Year Assessment Matching review process ends. The Fall Survey 2 and Spring Survey 3 RVT closes. Districts electing to use Survey 2 and 3 data instead of RVT for VAM purposes must have those data files finalized. The Assessment Matching review process ends.
Early/Mid Summer	 The Bureau posts files to the Teacher Accountability ShareFile folders with the Final VAM Inclusion information for district review. The district primary accountability contact in every district replies to the Bureau that the Final VAM Inclusion Files were compiled accurately.

Federal Uniform Graduation Rate

- All students must be accounted for.
- Only standard diplomas are included in the numerator.
- Does not remove transfers to adult education programs (i.e., remain in denominator).
- Assigns Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) students back to their most recent Florida public high school of enrollment.
