Nice job. This should work well for discussion in July.

Notes:

- a. membership statement should also include school district IS consortium members.
- b. we might discuss further the notion of establishing standing committees to address the major areas of mandated reporting to the DOE/Feds as a vehicle to address issues and proposed improvements, and include key DOE, legislative, and Federal staff; with each of these committees meeting on a continuing basis (at least annually), making recommendations and assisting with follow-through or research on needed changes in policies, procedures, or definitions. For example: course and subject area codes and tables; student enrollment and withdrawal; transcripts and grading; student discipline; special programs (ESE, ESOL...); student assessment. Each of these committees could make a brief report back to the overall Council at the Business meeting relating to action items and items in process...

I think the networking with FAEDS and it's member has many advantages, and having FAEDS deal with the administrative overhead is a plus; but the Council (FAMIS) needs not to loose it's identity and it's continuing

focus on database issues and reporting is fundamental and critical to all our IS efforts.

At the last FAEDS board meeting, the topic was raised that this was being considered and I did not hear any oppositions. The FAEDS board meets in July so it would be good if this could be polished prior to that meeting in the event FAMIS wishes the board to take further action. I browsed the attachment and could not find specifics as to how funds would be budgeted within the confines of the FAEDS master account. In fact, FAEDS is currently awaiting a budget from FAMIS so that we have some

accountability
in expenditures on behalf of FAMIS. I would add some bylaw language
that
requires FAMIS to adopt a budget to be submitted to the FAEDS treasurer
on
an annual basis. Our fiscal year starts July 1 so it would be good to
have the budget at our spring meeting.

I have cc'd the board on this draft so that they can review and provide
additional feedback. I have not been a member of FASA or any other
organization that has sub-groups such as this so I am hopeful someone
else
with more expertise in this area can provide more constructive feedback
than I have the capacity to provide. Thanks.
